**Subject: Rechecking of answer script of Common AAO Examination 2010.**

Sir,

I am directed to refer to your letters No. (i) 4(11)SAS/2011/Pr.AO/769-794 dated 21-09-2011 (ii) 4(11)SAS/2011/Pr.AO/884 dated 12-10-2011 (iii) 4(11)SAS/2011/Pr.AO/1269 dated 4-1-2012 and (iv) 4(11)SAS/2011/Pr.AO/1706 dated 21-02-2012 forwarding the representations of 51 failed candidates of Common AAO Examination conducted in February, 2011 for rechecking of the marks awarded to them.

2. The answer scripts of all the 51 candidates have been rechecked and it is found that there is no change in the marks awarded to any of them except in the two cases mentioned below:-

(i) In the case of Ms. Pooja Sehgal (Index No.DA/086, Part-II), 17 marks awarded to her for Question No. 3 of the paper on PWD Accounts was inadvertently omitted while totaling the marks for this subject. The marks actually secured by her in the subject is 92 and not 75, as mentioned in the original results already communicated to you vide this office letter No. A.34012/3340/2010/MF.CGA(E)/170 dated 29th July, 2011. As a result she may be treated as **"PASSED"** Part-II of Common AAO Exam held in February, 2011.

(ii) Shri Ramesh Kumar (Index No.DA/106, Part-II), was inadvertently treated as a General Category candidate, whereas as per information received from your office he belongs to SC Category. The pass mark required for SC/ST candidates is 35% in each subject and 40% in the aggregate. Since he has secured 35% marks in all the 3 subjects individually, and 40% marks in the aggregate he may also be treated as **"PASSED"** Part-II of Common AAO Exam held in February, 2011.

3. Necessary corrections in the results of these two candidates may please be made in your records.

4. The candidates may also be informed suitably.
